By creating a profile online at www.southcarolinablues.com, you can access “My Health Toolkit.” Doing so will give you access to all claims, eligibility info, deductible, out of pocket info, and the ability to request additional or replacement cards, etc. Everyone will be required to update information with BCBS about other insurance coverage you may have before any claims will be paid on your behalf. This annual update is required by all insurance carriers. You may complete the update online **after you create a profile on the BCBS website.**

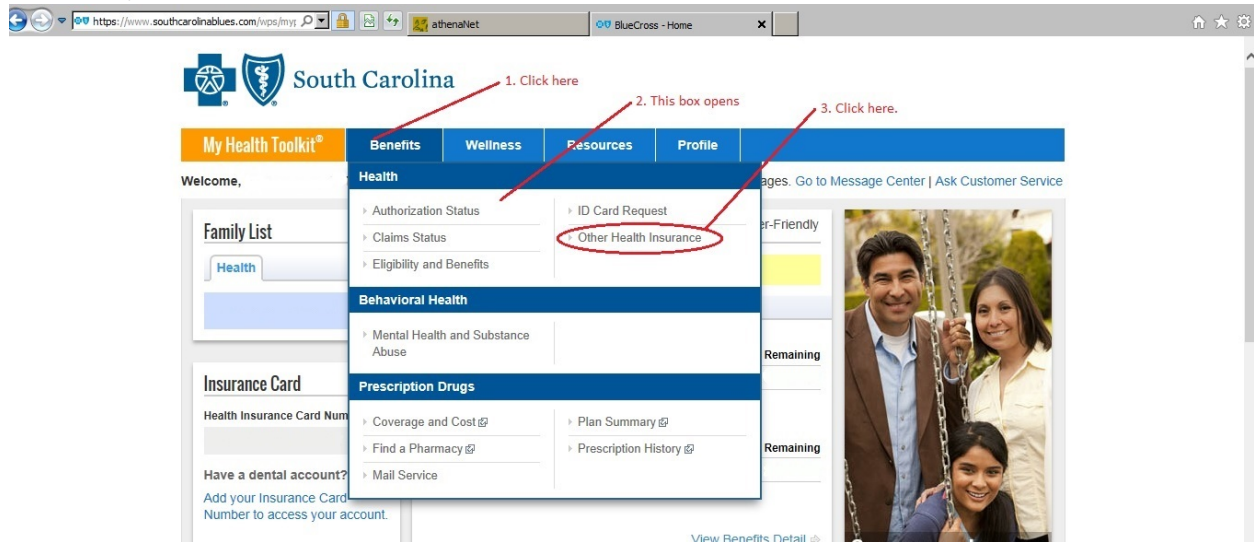

Once you are logged in, you can update your other insurances.

1. At the top of the screen you will see the orange and blue line with the words, “My Health Toolkit...”
2. Click on Benefits and a box will open.
3. In the box, click on Other Health Insurance.



4. Complete the pages that follow. If you do not have other health insurance (not even Medicare) click “No” and “update” and you should receive a message on the webpage stating that your insurance has been updated.
5. If you have other health insurance (including Medicare), click “yes” and be ready to provide the information that is generally found on your health Ins. ID card.
